5. Principal's Report – Mark Clay

- Thanks the PAC and all the volunteers for all the events and fundraising efforts.
- Thanks the parents that have helped out and for their work to help create "community" among the parents.
- Great and successful year. The school's Administration looks forward to the coming year and continuing to work with the PAC.
- June 5th was Professional Development Day A great session was held that highlighted the last 5-6 years at Maillard. The school has and will continue to change with the coming year.
- Global Citizenship will continue next year and how "we" impact\change the World.
- Changes to the teacher and administration pool will be coming and with only a few departures. Four new positions at Maillard have been posted and candidates are starting to be interviewed.

For his coming year, cross-catchments have been allowed/excepted (with no additional spots available at the start of the school year Maillard is full. As for next year (February), cross-catchment positions may not be offered due to school numbers and the addition of 2 divisions this year, totaling 15 divisions.

- Some topics countered school's view. Examples included:
